MMTC Congratulates Arielle Roth on Being Nominated to Lead NTIA

WASHINGTON, DC (February 11, 2025): The Multicultural Media, Telecom and Internet Council (MMTC) congratulates Arielle Roth, Policy Director for the U.S. Senate Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation, on being nominated by President Donald J.
